KS3: Year 9 Identity

Areas of Recap:

- Using the formal elements to develop drawings skills.
- Independent research skills
- Presentation and annotation

Skill development : Presentation

Students will build an awareness of how to put together effective sketchbook pages with a focus on composition, font styles and creative backgrounds

Skill development : Mixed Media

Inspired by a range of contextual sources students will develop skills working with mixed media. They will learn new layering and painting techniques and develop their awareness of composition.

Skill development : Ink Painting

Students will use Indian ink to create a stylised self-portrait on top of their mixed media backgrounds as part of their final outcome.

Skill development : Drawing

Students will develop their drawing skills focusing on the grid drawing technique.

There will be 1 Formative Drawing Assessment per rotation.



Local Context

Through their work students will celebrate the city of Liverpool- exploring their own favourite aspects of the city and its culture and taking inspiration from local architecture.

Artist Inspiration- Martine Rupert

Students will study the work of contemporary artist Martine Rupert. They will take inspiration from her mixed media techniques and layered style.

Developing a final piece

Students will use the mixed media and composition skills developed across both rotations to develop a final outcome. The piece will be based on their own portrait and aspects of their own identities.

Evaluating Art Work

Students will develop analytical and evaluation skills and suggest improvements for future studies
