KS3: Year 7 Religious Education

Understanding the faith

Throughout year 7 students are given the opportunity to explore their own faith and spirituality. We focus on the development of Christianity and make comparisons to other world religions. Students are also given time to explore their own spiritual journey along the way.

Inspirational People

Students have the opportunity to explore some examples of inspirational people throughout history and reflect on who inspires them today.

What Would Jesus Do?

Students will recognise the importance of Jesus' most well-known teachings and develop key skills in analysing parables and miracles to understand their meaning.

Places of Worship

Students will study a range of places of worship from the 6 world religions; Christianity, Islam, Judaism, Hinduism, Buddhism, and Sikhism.

Multifaith Britain

Students will explore the diverse country we live in and explore different aspects that have allowed Britain to be a multicultural society.

Belonging

We explore the history of the Sisters of Mercy, the role of Catherine McAuley and the part we play in the larger Mercy community.

We also explore what it means to belong in a new school community.

Why Was Jesus Great?

Students will examine the historical context to which Jesus grew up in, and explore his ministry and how it developed.

What is Love?

Students will reflect on their own actions and learn how they can apply Jesus' teachings to their daily life.

Wealth and Poverty

Students will identify the difference between Absolute and Relative poverty and explore real life examples of people living in extreme poverty around the world. Students will be made aware of what different religions actively do to help those in need.
