COVID -19 BEHAVIOUR FOR LEARNING POLICY ADDENDUM



All students should continue to adhere to the principles outlined in the school's Behaviour for Learning policy whilst in school or when self-isolating.

Therefore, when self-isolating and interacting with other students and staff online, students should always be kind and respectful to each other and to staff.

Students should never attempt to contact staff via social media. Any inappropriate comments to students or staff online, via email or any other platform will be taken very seriously. This is also the case of for any online bullying towards other students or peer-on-peer abuse that is disclosed to the school during this time.

If students are interacting with teachers via online lessons, they should be aware of the following:

- Students' behaviour and comments should reflect how they would behave in a lesson in school
- Students should address teachers and refer to peers as they would do in a classroom setting
- Students working in school during this time should adhere to the school's Behaviour for Learning policy, as well as implementing the social distancing protocols and procedures implemented by the school.

The following outlines the school's expectations of both students and parents / carers:

- If your daughter has any of the following symptoms, high temperature (37.8 degrees or above), has a persistent cough or loss of taste or smell, they MUST NOT come into school and must be kept at home
- Students should arrive for 8.40am (Yrs 7-9), 8.55am (Yrs10 & 11) and will be dismissed at 2.45pm (Yrs 7-9), 3.00pm (Yrs10 & 11)
- Parents will not be permitted on the school site
- Parents and students will not be allowed to gather at the school gates or outside of the school premises
- Students should make their own way to and from school and where possible, avoid using public transport
- On entering the school site, students should ensure they sanitise or wash their hands, and where possible remain 2 metres apart, there are guide lines on the paths and corridors to support this
- Students will be placed in bubbles and will remain in these bubbles throughout the school day. They will not be allowed to swap into other bubbles
- Students must not share resources and need to provide their own writing equipment
- Signage will be used to remind all parents/students and staff of the need to socially distance and adhere to the restrictions in use
- All pupils are to remain 2 metres away from teaching staff
- Corridors (where appropriate) will have a one-way system operation and socially distanced lines marked out to aid with this
- Movement around school will be restricted/timetabled to avoid group mixing and cross contamination
- bubbles will be limited to ensure social distancing and in line with staff and room availability
- Students will sit at desks socially distanced from the teacher
- Staff and students MUST wear a mask when in communal areas e.g. corridors
- No whole school assemblies
- Toilets will be allocated to bubbles to avoid bubbles mixing
- There will be reminders on hygiene through the day, visual and verbal reminders will be used for handwashing and social distancing
- Hand sanitiser MUST be used on entry to the school building and during the school day
- There is a supply of disposable tissues in each room to implement the 'catch it, bin it, kill it' approach in each classroom
- Rooms will be well ventilated, windows and doors open

- An isolation room is available in case anyone shows symptoms (staff to use PPE if this occurs)
- Students who show symptoms will be isolated and collected from school as soon as possible
- Lunch and break times will be staggered
- All lunches MUST be paid for in advance through Parent Pay
- Students entitled to free school meals will be provided with a meal while in school
- Students should adhere to social distancing restrictions during both break and lunch time
- Students to eat food independently, staff will not be permitted to help with opening of packets, bottles, etc
- No lunchboxes are permitted-if you are supplying a packed lunch this must be in a disposable bag/cover

All staff are responsible in setting the tone and context for positive behaviour within the classroom. They will model and display expectations for social distancing and good hygiene within the classroom and in all shared areas of the school site. They will establish clear routines for hygiene and maintaining social distancing within school.

However, if a student is finding it difficult to adhere to these expectations, every attempt will be made to support the pupil in understanding the expectations and reasoning behind them. If a student continuously and/or deliberately fails to follow instruction, we would be unable to provide a safe place for the student during this period of time, as their behaviour could be compromising the health and safety of students and staff on site. Please note, that all staff are being deployed to work with bubbles of students, therefore there are no spare staff to spend large periods of time 1:1 with students who are displaying inappropriate behaviours.
