'I could not see the presentation screen because we were by the door – there were no seats'

'We think the girls need more information about the electives choices on offer'

***(The purpose of the evening is an opportunity for you to find about what the subjects are about in Years 10 and 11, the girls also have subject specific assemblies on what the subject entails in Year 10 and 11.
