Sixth Form Taster Day

Your daughter is invited to attend the **Year 12 Taster Day on Monday 26th June**. The taster day is compulsory for all prospective students and is designed to prepare your daughter for her Study Programme in September.

The aims of the taster day are:

1. Gain a better understanding of what courses she may study within her Study Programme.
2. Receive information about collecting GCSE results and completing the online registration for Sixth Form.
3. Receive induction and enrolment details for September.
4. Have the opportunity to clarify any questions she may have.
5. Receive summer preparatory work in each of her chosen subjects. This is to be completed over the summer and handed in on the first lesson back in September.
6. Be made aware of other aspects to the Sixth Form Study Programme, including Community Hours, Enrichment and Work Experience

Your daughter will have full use of the Sixth Form facilities. Refreshments are available to buy in the Sixth Form Café and lunch can also be purchased. Students who are in receipt of free school meals will also be able to have lunch in this area. Your daughter will be allowed off site at lunch time as are all Sixth Form students.

The dress code for the day is smart black and white. Whilst this is open to interpretation it does not include jeans, track suits, trainers, flip flops or leisure wear.

Please report to the Sixth Form reception by 8.40 am where your daughter will be welcomed and invited to wait in the Sixth form Café. Your daughter will then be registered and given further information for the day.

Your daughter will need to bring some writing equipment with her for the taster sessions and a small notebook for her to note down details of summer work that needs to be completed.

Your daughter will need to attend sessions for subjects she is considering studying in year 12. Advice will be given to your daughter if some of her chosen subjects are being offered during the same taster session. Should you have any questions, please contact the Sixth Form team.
