Thank you to all those parents who took the time to complete our year 10 parents evening survey. In total we had 50 responses.

This year we have introduced 'class charts' as a tool both staff and parents can use to record and monitor behaviour in class. Parents can download the 'class charts' app for free onto their mobile phones or tablets and see daily how their children are behaving. The app also shows how the vast majority of our pupils are being recognised and rewarded for their good behaviours. There is a guide to downloading the free app on our school website, we would appreciate all parents accessing the app if possible. If there is any cause for concern with regard to your daughter's progress or behaviour in particular lessons please contact the year 10 team to discuss these further.

The following comments were given in the parental feedback question 15:

"My child has been moved down in some subjects and I have not been informed by the school. I have never been asked to support my child's learning by the school"

The nature of our setting across key stage 4 allows fluidity of support for pupils. Pupils may be moved up or down sets in subjects in order to enable staff to meet their individual needs. We will strive to inform all parents of class movements and we certainly take on board the comment made for the future. Ways parents can support pupils as they prepare for their GCSE examinations can be found on the school website 'Parents' section.

"I would like to know if the same teachers will be teaching in year 11 as year 10"

Continuity is important for all pupils whilst completing courses, however this is not always possible due to staffing.
