## Year 12 Mock Examinations Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> December – Friday 16<sup>th</sup> December 2016

Some Year 12 students will sit a Mock exam on Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> December through to Friday 16<sup>th</sup> December. These mocks are for subjects that have an external exam in 2017 and affect the following subjects.

Photography, Art, Media, Government and Politics, Product Design, Textiles, Maths, ICT, Applied Business and Marketing. A copy of their timetable will follow.

Throughout the examination days, registration is suspended but students are required to attend all other lessons for vocational and reformed subjects.

For a morning exam, students must sign into sixth form at 8.40am and for an afternoon exam, they must sign in by 12:40pm. Students sitting a mock exam must wait in the sixth form café where they will be registered and taken to the examination room. Please note that equipment must be in a clear bag, bottled water is allowed in the examination rooms but must be in a sports bottle with all labels removed.

Parents must be advised that any student found in possession of a mobile telephone whilst in an examination room, will have that examination paper disqualified. This contravention of examination rules can also result in all other examination papers being cancelled.
