## Year 13 Mock Examinations Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> December – Friday 16<sup>th</sup> December 2016

Year 13 students will begin their mock examinations on Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> December through to Friday 16<sup>th</sup> December, a copy of their timetable will follow.

**Please note that all Year 13 will sit a mock exam for examined subjects.** Throughout the examination days, registration is suspended and students are only required to attend a lesson for a vocational subject.

For a morning exam, students must sign into sixth form at 8.40am and for an afternoon exam, they must sign in by 12:40pm. Students sitting a mock exam must wait in the sixth form café where they will be registered and taken to the examination room. Please note that equipment must be in a clear bag, bottled water is allowed in the examination rooms but must be in a sports bottle with all labels removed.

Parents must be advised that any student found in possession of a mobile telephone whilst in an examination room, will have that examination paper disqualified. This contravention of examination rules can also result in all other examination papers being cancelled.

If your son/daughter is absent from any given examination please contact Mrs Barnes on 541 9452.

If students are up to date with work and have completed all of their mock examinations, they are permitted to finish for Christmas at 3:10pm on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> December. Students who have outstanding work will finish on Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> December. Students who have achieved 100% attendance have been invited to attend a reward trip to Chester on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> December. Any student not attending the trip will attend sixth form as normal that day.

Mock results will be issued on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> January and Mock resists have been organised for the week beginning Monday 16<sup>th</sup> January for any students who significantly underachieve and require additional support to improve their grades. Mock resists will be taken afterschool.
