

## **Feedback from Questionnaire Year 9 parents evening**

- 74 Questionnaires returned.
- Majority ticked strongly agree/agree
- 3 Parents tended to disagree that their daughter is making steady progress
- 2 Parents found teachers hard to locate
- 2 parents found the meetings unhelpful

(Dealt with on the night. Discussion with pupil regarding accepting of criticism. We will be monitoring the situation over coming weeks.)

'No I was not! I was insulted by a teacher!' (Dealt with on the evening. Parent raised concerns with the Progress Manager. Subject teacher had advised pupil not to take subject. The pupil has made an informed choice to opt for this subject at GCSE. Staff and pupil will work together to support this decision. Ongoing monitoring agreed.)

'New system is confusing.'  
(We will publish information on the website to support parents with regards to changes in grades.)

'I am aware that my daughter's poor attendance is holding her back.'  
(School will work with the pupil and her family to support improved attendance..)
