We have recently received the following information which may be of interest and would like to draw it to your attention.

HOME ACCESS GRANT

The Home Access is a Government programme that will help more families get online. If any parents in schools earn below the threshold of approximately £16,000 they will be able to apply for a computer and a year's free internet access.

For a quick eligibility check you must be able to answer "yes" to 3 questions in Section 1 and answer "yes" to at least 1 question in Section 2.
