- There have been recorded incidents of collisions involving pupils at Liverpool Schools caused through parked cars moving off and reversing, especially if on the pavements, and close to junctions.
- Visibility for the pedestrian and motorist is a priority whilst crossing and the pupils are easily masked by the cars.
- Please park in a safe legal place, even if it means pupils walking a short distance to the school.
- It is also a constant source of complaint from residents and motorists in the local neighbourhood.
