KS3: Year 8 2D Art Architecture

Areas of Recap:

- Using the formal elements to develop drawings skills.
- Independent research skills
- Presentation and annotation



What is Architecture ?:

Discussion about the meaning, purpose and misconceptions of Architecture.

Skill development : Presentation

Students will build an awareness of how to put together effective sketchbook pages with a focus on composition, font styles and creative thinking.



Exploring Local Architecture

Students will gain knowledge and understanding of local Liverpool landmarks and explore the ever changing skyline.

Skill development : Drawing

Students will use a variety of different drawing techniques from tonal and technical to a looser and more gestural style.



Artist Research

Students will compare and contrast the work of local artist Freida McKittrick and mixed media, international artist Martine Rupert. They will understand what influences the artists and how to work inspired by their styles.

Skill development : Collage

Students will develop their skills using collage looking into the history of collage and being inspired by Liverpool Skyline piece.



Developing a 2D Outcome

Based on their understanding of the artists and buildings they have studied students will develop a mixed media final piece.

Skill development: Mixed Media

Using a range of media such as papers, paints, pencils and pen, students will develop their skills and understanding of layering, composition and experimentation.
