

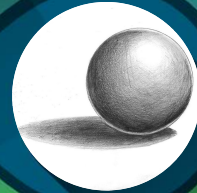
# KS3: Year 8 3D Art Birds

## Areas of Recap:

- Using the formal elements to develop drawings skills.
- Independent research skills

## Understanding 3D form

Students will gain an understanding of how the 3D form differs from 2D art and design

## Skill development : Presentation

Students will build an awareness of how to put together effective sketchbook pages with a focus on composition, font styles and creative backgrounds



## Artist Research

Students will compare and contrast the work of 3D artist who work with newsprint Suzanne Breakwell and Julie Dodd

## Skill development : 3D Drawing

Students will use drawing techniques from tonal and technical styles to explore how to draw in 2D an outcome that looks 3D.



## Developing a 3D Outcome

Based on their understanding of the artists they have studied students and the technique of using newsprint to build sculpture's students will produce a 3D final piece

## Skill development : Sculpture

Students will develop their skills using 3D paper modeling and paper collage technique to produce a 3D bird .



## Evaluating art work

Students will develop analytical and evaluation skills and suggest improvements for future studies .

## Skill development : 3D Drawing

Students will further develop their 3D drawing skills by live drawing , from the 3D outcome they have made
